David Riffe in 1863 bought a farm in Howard County, Indiana, and with his family moved to this farm near Young America, Ind. Here the second wife, Mary, died June 4, 1865, at the age of 28 years, 11 months, and 12 days.

In 1867 he married Susan Wilson and with his children they lived on the farm until 1887 when they moved to Young America, Ind. Here on December 13, 1890, he lost his third wife, Susan.

In 1891 he married Elizabeth Snyder, with whom he lived until his death, on December 21, 1902.

David Riffe at an early age united with the Shiloh Methodist Church in Decatur County, Indiana. After moving to Howard County, Indiana, he transferred his membership to the Sharon Baptist Church where he served as a deacon. He became a charter member of the Young America Baptist Church which was organized in 1882. To this early church his contribution of material means, regular attendance and spiritual worship established for him in the minds of his fellow men a high regard for the sincerity of his faith and deep reverence for his loyalty to convictions. He served as deacon in this church until his death.

He was also a member of Masonic Lodge No. 534 at Young America.

(6) Joseph Riley Riffe⁶ was born in Shelby County, Indiana, April 22, 1863. He made his early home with his father David

Riffe, and stepmother, Susan Riffe. He received his education from the district school of Poplar Grove. He was united in marriage to Jennie Hoover on June 18, 1887. 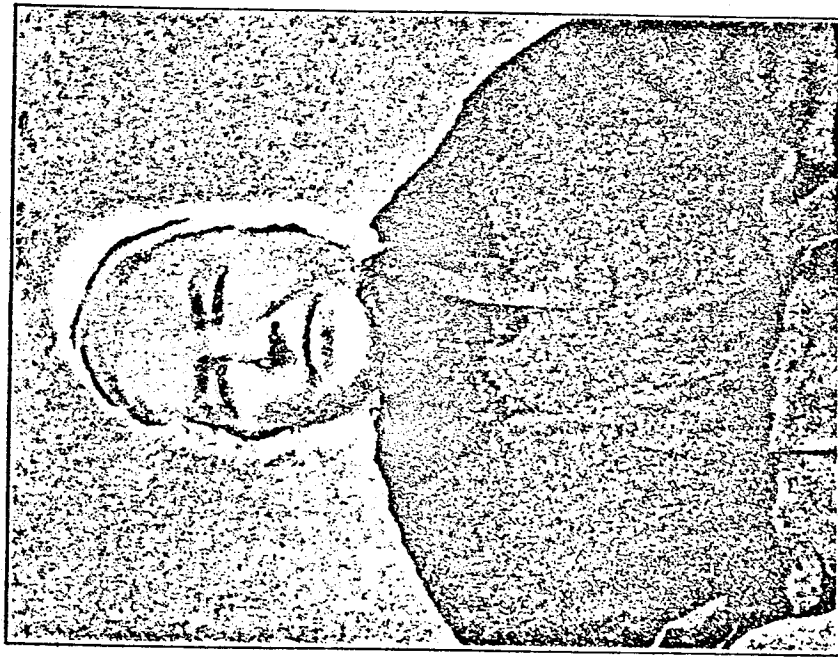
